**Rashaad Slowley, Southern Connecticut** (So., RB, Mount Vernon, N.Y.) - Broke out for a career-high 221 yards on 17 carries and scored three touchdowns in Saturday's 71-14 win over Saint Anselm. Rushed for scores of 6, 1 and 80 yards. It was his fourth game of the year with at least 100 yards and first 200+ yard outing.

## NORTHEAST-10 DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK



**Jason Fischer, Merrimack** (So., CB, South Hereford, Md.) - Became the first player in school history to get three interceptions in a game versus Pace. Returned his second interception 52 yards for his first career touchdown.

## NORTHEAST-10 FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK



**Jareed Gaines, Stonehill** (Fr., DB, Lumberton, N.J.) - Led the Stonehill defense with eight tackles (six solo), including one for a loss of two yards, a pass breakup and blocked field goal in Saturday's 23-21 win over 24th-ranked Bentley. Broke up a pass on third and ten at the Skyhawks 22 and then blocked the ensuing field goal attempt to preserve a 17-14 lead. Stonehill then marched down and scored the game-clinching touchdown.

## 2009 NORTHEAST-10 FOOTBALL WEEKLY INFORMATION



**AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL:** AIC closed the season with a 3-7 loss to Assumption. The Yellow Jackets ended the season at 5-5 overall and 3-5 in the NE-10. Senior quarterback Shane Murphy completed 18-of-33 passes for 162 yards and one touchdown. He finished his collegiate career with 2,763 career-passing yards, placing him ninth on the career passing yardage list. Senior wide receiver Kertis Hussey caught seven passes for 71 yards and a score. He closed out his AIC career ranked second in career receptions with 162, fourth in career receiving yards with 2,175 and seventh in scoring with 178 career points. Senior linebacker Rich Reichert had a game-high 15 tackles for the Yellow Jackets, while junior linebacker George Hudson registered 13 tackles with 1.5 tackles for loss. Junior linebacker Terrance Holley had eight tackles with one blocked kick and one fumble recovery.



**ASSUMPTION:** The Hounds 3-7 win over American International improved the Greyhounds overall record to 6-4 (5-3 in the conference) under returning coach Cory Bailey and their first six-win season since 1995. They are among the most improved teams in the nation after struggling last season at 1-9. Senior linebacker Dustin Zitzmann (Pinellas Park, Fla.) had 10 tackles to set the career mark for tackles (414). The only player in Greyhound history with three 100-tackle seasons finished the season with 45-68-112 tackles and became the career leader eclipsing Bill Guilfoil (1990-92, 94) who finished his Hall of Fame career with 275-134-409. He also put the finishing touch on a superb career by tying the Greyhound mark for the longest interception return (99 yards) for a touchdown. The team set a season record with 309 points and scored over 30 points six times. Junior running back Herbert Woodard (Bridgeton, N.J.) finished the season with 1,175 yards (fourth-best in Hounds history) on 223 carries with a record 17 rushing TDs and a record 18 overall. He also tied the season mark with seven 100-yard rushing games and has now 546 carries for 2,691 yards and 12 career 100-yard games with 33 rushing touchdowns (36 overall) and a record 108 points this season and 216 points in his career. Junior wide receiver David Canney (Templeton, Mass.) caught eight passes for 90 yards to finish his season with 59 receptions for 778 yards and nine touchdowns. In his three-year career he has 153 receptions (just five short of the career mark of Jake Beers (2004-07) for 1,966 yards (just 100 yards short of Eric Mauer's (1997-00) career mark of 2,066 yards and 15 touchdowns (second). Canney now has 96 career points.



**BENTLEY:** Bentley's 23-21 loss to Stonehill not only cost the Falcons sole possession of first place in the Northeast-10 but also knocked them out of the NCAA Division II playoffs. Bentley, fourth in last week's Super Region One, dropped out of the top eight with the loss, and finished the season at 8-2, with both losses by two points. QB Bryant Johnson (Hopedale, Mass.), WR John Malone (Walpole, Mass.) and OL Jared Kawadler (Sharon, Mass.), all juniors, were named to the ESPN the Magazine Academic All-District 1 college division first team. Senior Tyler McNamara (Medway, Mass.), the most prolific FG kicker in Bentley and Northeast-10 history, was recognized by the Fred Mitchell Award for the second straight month. Senior LB Matt Zahoruiko (North Andover, Mass.) finished the season with 123 tackles, the most in 22 seasons of varsity football at Bentley. Grad student Kelley Rowe (Toledo, Ohio) finished his career with exactly 100 receptions, becoming the seventh Falcon to reach that milestone.



**MERRIMACK:** The Merrimack football team clinched a share of its second Northeast-10 Championship, defeating Pace University 46-14. The Warriors rushed for 404 yards in the win, second most in school history and the most since September 18, 1998. Anthony Smalls (Dorchester, Mass.) became the second player in school history to rush for 1,000 career yards with 187 yards against Pace. Smalls finished with 1,116 yards in eight games, averaging 145.1 per game, tops in the conference. James Suozzo (Everett, Mass.) was 46 yards shy of becoming the first quarterback in school history with 1,000 yards. Suozzo only completed five passes in the win. Jason Fischer (South Hereford, Md.) became the first Merrimack player with three interceptions in a game. Fischer returned his second pick 52 yards for a touchdown. Merrimack intercepted five passes in all. Shawn Loiseau (Shrewsbury, Mass.) added 12 more tackles to his school record of 123 tackles in a season. The Warriors wasted no time putting the game away against Pace, picking up 37 first-half points, despite running just 21 plays and no more than four on any scoring drive. The Warriors set the school mark for points in a season with 349,

passing the old mark of 306. Merrimack completes the regular season as the conference leader in points per game (34.9), rushing offense (251.6), total offense (482.6), first downs (226), and sacks against (11).



**NEW HAVEN:** The Chargers concluded the 2009 season with a 42-13 loss to non-conference opponent Ohio Dominican (NAIA) at DellaCamera Stadium Saturday afternoon. The Chargers were unable to stop the Panthers balanced offensive attack, while the UNH offense struggled to get started. Desmond Anderson led the UNH defense with 15 total tackles, while quarterback Ryan Osiecki led the offense with 215 total yards. In their first season competing since 2003, the Chargers went 5-5 overall and 4-4 in the NE-10.



**PACE:** Pace finished their season at 1-9 overall and 1-7 in conference play. Senior running back Nathaniel Ford finished his career with 1,439 rushing yards, which ranks him sixth in school history. Senior defensive back Greg Brain end his Pace career tied for fifth in school history in interceptions with 11. Senior tight end Andrew Kulak ends his Setter career with 79 receptions for 950 yards and five touchdowns.



**SAINT ANSELM:** Saint Anselm ended the season at 2-8 overall and 1-7 in the Northeast-10 following a home loss to Southern Connecticut. Michael Pierce threw for two touchdowns on the day, giving him a Saint Anselm single-season record 21 touchdown passes in 2009. Pierce ends the season with single-season school records for passing attempts, completions, passing yards, total offense and passing touchdowns. Sophomore Marc Wilson caught eight passes for 50 yards and ends the season with a single-season record 82 passes for a record 860 yards and seven touchdowns. His seven touchdowns tie a single-season record. Senior All-America candidate Dan Bohenek had 10 tackles for the Hawks and ended his career with 283 total tackles, including 183 solo stops. His 283 total tackles is second all-time at Saint Anselm, while his 183 solo stops is a school record. Bohenek ended 2009 with 114 total tackles, also a Saint Anselm single-season school record.



**SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT:** Seven different players scored touchdowns as the Southern Connecticut State University football team rolled past Saint Anselm in its regular season finale on Saturday, 71-14. Thanks to the SCSU win and Bentley's loss on Saturday, the Owls finish the season as Northeast-10 Conference tri-champions. It's the second time in the last four years that the Owls have earned at least a share of the league title. Southern Connecticut finishes the year with a 6-4 mark, its ninth straight winning season and 16th straight year with a record at or above .500. In the process, the Owls also set a new program single-game mark with 691 yards of total offense, eclipsing the old mark of 642 set back in 1996 in a game against Mansfield. The 71 points were the third highest single-game total in program history. The Owls scored 78 points against AIC in 1955 and 77 against Bryant in 2005. Chris Roberts finished 11-of-14 for 244 yards and four touchdowns. John Wiechman rushed for 121 yards on 21 carries and one touchdown. Andre Privott had three catches for 126 yards and two touchdowns. Andrew Pratt returned an interception 41 yards for a touchdown, marking the first time since the 2007 contest at Saint Anselm that an Owl returned a pick for a touchdown.



**STONEHILL:** Stonehill closed out the season with a 23-21 victory over Bentley, ranked 24th nationally... The Skyhawks finished the season with a three-game winning streak and winners of four of their last five for a 5-5 record overall, finishing .500 for the second time in three years - marking the first such occurrence since the mid-1990's. Junior running back Eddie Vachon (Newton, Mass.) finished with 208 all-purpose yards, becoming the program's career leader in that category with 3,281 yards in 36 career games. Vachon rushed for 176 yards against the NE-10's second-ranked rush defense. Sophomore cornerback/kick returner Stephan Neville (Foxborough, Mass.) posted his third kick return for a touchdown (fourth career) when he took the opening kickoff 94-yards for a score on Saturday. The Skyhawks picked up a fumble on the ensuing kickoff and Vachon scored to give Stonehill a 14-0 lead a minute into the contest. Freshman Jared Gaines (Lumberton, N.J.) blocked a kick for the second-straight week.
