## 2009 NORTHEAST-10 FOOTBALL WEEKLY INFORMATION



**AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL:** AIC posted a 17-14 win over Saint Anselm Saturday to snap a two-game losing skid. Senior Kertis Hussey opened the scoring with a 90-yard punt return for a touchdown in the closing minute of the first half and freshman Fateen Brown scored on his only carry of the day for a two-yard score to open the second half scoring. Senior kicker Dan Bassani hit what proved to be a game-winning 21-yard field goal with 2:14 to go in the third quarter.



**ASSUMPTION:** Junior quarterback Andrew Kupec (Wyckoff, N.J.) had a team-record five touchdown passes in the 34-26 win at Pace. Kupec also set the team mark for consecutive completions, 13 over two games and 11 to start the game against Pace. Kupec was 25-for-31 for 343 yards, the second-most completions and yards in a game for the Greyhounds. Junior running back Herbert (Pop) Woodard (Bridgeton, N.J.) had 22 rushes for 68 yards and now has 416 career carries eclipsing the career mark formerly held by Fran DeFalco '95 at 398 and 2,056 yards, second only to DeFalco's 2,289. Junior wide receiver David Canney (Templeton, Mass.) became the first player in Hounds history with three 10-reception games and the first with back-to-back. He had a career-best 11 receptions for 124 yards vs. Pace and last week (vs. So. Connecticut) had 10 receptions for 157 yards for a two-game total of 21 catches for 281 yards. He now has 126 career receptions (third on career list) for 1,662 yards. Senior linebacker Dustin Zitzmann (Pinellas Park, Fla.) had 10 tackles and now has 364 in his career, third best in Hounds history.



**BENTLEY:** Senior Tyler McNamara (Medway, Mass.), the top field goal kicker in Northeast-10 history, added to his impressive resume in Saturday's loss to Merrimack. He kicked four field goals, setting a Bentley single game record and tying the conference record, and also broke the Northeast-10 career mark for points by a kicker. He now has 199, surpassing the 192 amassed by Tim Wagner of C.W. Post from 2000-02. McNamara's 39 career field goals include 10 in his last three games. The Falcons tasted defeat for the first time in 2009 despite 420 yards of total offense and 23 first downs.



**MERRIMACK:** After defeating Bentley 14-12, Merrimack is 3-0 in Northeast-10 play for the first time in school history. The four-game winning streak is the first since the 2006 season. The nation's third-ranked offense was limited to just 14 points in a 1:47 span in the game, but the defense came through forcing three turnovers and surrendering just four field goals. Anthony Smalls (Dorchester, Mass.) was over the 100-yard mark rushing for the fifth straight game. Chris Laham (Westwood, Mass.) caught his conference-best 10th touchdown as the Warriors beat Bentley at home for the first time since 2000. The Merrimack defense stood out in the win as Tony Johnson (Lynn, Mass.) now leads the conference in tackles for a loss and is second in sacks, while Nick DesJardins (Somerville, Mass.) is tops in fumbles forced with four. Merrimack goes for its fifth-straight win Saturday at Assumption.



**NEW HAVEN:** The Chargers fell 54-26 Friday night at cross-town rival Southern Connecticut State University. The Chargers were led by quarterback Ryan Osiecki with 386 yards and three touchdowns on 37-of-61 passing. Jason Thompson led the UNH receivers with 101 yards and a touchdown on five catches, while Shariëff Hall added nine catches for 83 yards and a touchdown. Defensively, New Haven was led by Akaki Ramishvili for the second-straight week. He tallied 11 total tackles, a sack and a fumble recovery. The Chargers return to DellaCamera Stadium this week as they host American International at 1 p.m.



**PACE:** Running back Nathaniel Ford rushed for 74 yards and two touchdowns in a loss to Assumption College. Ford moved into seventh place all-time in school history with 1,346 career rushing yards and 11 career rushing touchdowns. Quarterback Ray Gregg moved into sixth place in Pace history on the career passing touchdown list with 16. The last time the Setters opened a season at 0-5 was 2004.



**SAINT ANSELM:** Saint Anselm rallied from a 17-0 deficit in the fourth quarter to pull to within 17-14 before falling to AIC by the 17-14 final. Sophomore Marc Wilson made his first start at quarterback for the Hawks, playing the entire first quarter. Wilson also came in late in the game and tossed a seven-yard scoring pass to Marcel Bouie to get within 17-14. Wilson was the team's top receiver with six catches for 70 yards, as well as the team's top rusher with 71 yards. He also added 28 kickoff return yards and was on the field for every offensive and special teams play of the day. Michael Pierce completed 19-of-44 passes for 206 yards and one touchdown and now has 12 touchdown passes this season. Senior All-America candidate Dan Bohenek, the fourth-leading tackler in the Northeast-10 this season, had a season-high 14 tackles, including nine solo stops. He now has double-digit tackle totals in five of his six games this season. Freshman Chris Bent is the leading freshman tackler in the league with 8.8 tackles per contest. Bent finished with eight tackles on Saturday, including one for a loss. The Hawks have a bye this week before hosting Assumption College for their homecoming game on Saturday, October 17th. Kickoff is set for 1 p.m. at Grappone Stadium.



**SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT:** The Owls have now won four in a row following Friday's 54-26 triumph over New Haven. The 54 points were a season-high for Southern Connecticut. Senior quarterback Chris Roberts (New Britain, Conn.) finished 14-of-21 for 251 yards and three touchdowns. Sophomore Rashaad Slowley (Mount Vernon, N.Y.) actually paced the Owls on the ground with 128 yards on 16 carries. He also scored a touchdown in the game. Jerome Pinckney (Ellenwood, Ga.) led the defense with 11 tackles. With the win, the Owls have now won their last 26 regular season games on or after Oct. 1.



**STONEHILL:** Stonehill looks to bounce back after the bye this past weekend as it hosts Pace University on Saturday for just the Skyhawks second home game of the season. The game will be broadcast live on [www.northeast10.tv](http://www.northeast10.tv) and [www.stonehillskyhawks.tv](http://www.stonehillskyhawks.tv) as part of the NE-10 Game of the Week package. The Skyhawks have dropped three-straight entering the bye.
