**Herb Woodard, Assumption (Jr., RB, Bridgton, N.J.)** - Ran for 222 yards and a touchdown on 37 carries in Assumption's 39-36 win over Merrimack. Woodard is 11 yards short of becoming the all-time leading rusher in Greyhounds history.

**Chris Carroll, Bentley (Sr., FS, Lynn, Mass.)** - Made three interceptions, tying the Bentley single game record, and also had five tackles, including one for a loss, as Bentley snapped Southern Connecticut's 10-game regular season conference winning streak with a 17-14 victory. First INT came in second quarter and led to Falcon go-ahead TD, second came at Bentley 14 with score tied and was returned 42 yards, and third came at Bentley 22 with the game still tied.

**Jareed Gaines, Stonehill (Fr., DB, Lumberton, N.J.)** - Led Stonehill with 13 tackles (seven solo) in Saturday's 34-14 win over Pace. Collected 1.0 sacks for a loss of six yards. Key member of a Skyhawks defense that held the Setters to just 14 points and only 62 yards rushing on the day.

## 2009 NORTHEAST-10 FOOTBALL WEEKLY INFORMATION



**AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL:** AIC dropped a 28-25 decision at New Haven last week. Senior quarterback Murphy played well in his first start in over two years, completing 22-of-38 passes for 278 yards and two TDs. He hit junior wide receiver Davon LeGrier on a 61-yard scoring play and hit senior wide receiver Kertis Hussey on a 25-yard scoring play. Senior running back Amadeus Guerrero-Pou had 19 carries for 61 yards and scored one TD. Senior linebacker Terrance Holley had a team-best eight tackles (six solo) with 2.5 tackles for loss and two sacks.



**ASSUMPTION:** Junior running back Herbert Woodard (Bridgton, Mass.) rushed 37 times for 222 yards in the 39-36 win over Merrimack and is the fifth in Hound history with two 200-yard rushing games. He has rushed for 2,278 yards, just 11 yards short of the career mark set by Fran DeFalco (1992-94) with 2,289. Junior wide receiver David Canney (Templeton, Mass.) caught five passes for 72 yards and two touchdowns and now has 37 receptions for 546 yards and seven TDs this year and 131 catches for 1,734 yards (both third in Hounds career records). The defense as usual, was led by senior middle linebacker Dustin Zitzmann (Pinellas Park, Fla.) with 3-8--11 tackles. He now has a league leading 30-44--74 tackles and for his career 139-236--375 tackles, just behind Scott Stephens (1989-92) (387) and Bill Guilfoil (1990, 92-94) (409).



**BENTLEY:** Senior FS Chris Carroll (Lynn, Mass.) tied the Bentley single game record with three interceptions during Friday's 17-14 win over Southern Connecticut, a victory that helped the Falcons move into a tie for first in the Northeast-10. Senior LB Matt Zahoruiko (North Andover, Mass.) also had a big game against the Owls, tying his career-best with 15 tackles while boosting his season average to 12.3. Senior K Tyler McNamara (Medway, Mass.) broke the 14-14 tie with an 18-yard field goal with 10:16 left in the fourth. It was his 40th career three-pointer and 11th in his last four games. Earlier in the game, McNamara became the fifth player in the program's history to reach the 200 career point plateau and recovered a fumble on a kickoff. Bentley, a perfect 5-0 in night games this season, was sixth in last week's NCAA Division II Super Region One rankings. Bentley's first seven opponents are averaging 25.8 points overall this season, but the Falcon defense has held them to an average of 13.3. They are also a combined 22-10 in games not against Bentley. The Falcons entered the game as the least penalized team in Division II in terms of yards, and did nothing to hurt themselves against Southern Connecticut. Only one penalty was assessed against the Falcons, and that was for 0 yards (an intentional grounding, which counts as a sack and loss of down rather than penalty yards). Through seven games, the Falcons average just 3.7 flags against and 25 yards.



**MERRIMACK:** Merrimack, tenth in the first edition of the regional rankings, saw its four-game winning streak snapped by Assumption 39-36 on Saturday, becoming the last Northeast-10 team to lose a conference game. The Warriors actually trailed 30-7 but fought back to cut the deficit to just three. Jeremiah Watts (Clovis, Calif.) caught 15 balls for a career-high 215 yards and two scores. James Suozzo (Everett, MA) threw 46 times, completing 32 passes for 369 yards and three touchdowns. Shawn Loiseau (Shrewsbury, Mass.) and Jesse Fowler (Lynn, Mass.) each registered their first career interception in the loss. Loiseau picked up a game-high 16 tackles. Merrimack looks to bounce back next Saturday when it hosts New Haven at 1 p.m. as part of Homecoming Weekend.



**NEWHAVEN:** The Chargers grabbed their second Northeast-10 Conference win of the season on Saturday in a 28-25 victory over American International College at DellaCamera Stadium. Shariief Hall took a 90-yard kickoff return for a touchdown with 13:18 left in the fourth quarter to give UNH the winning score. After allowing one more AIC score, the New Haven defense stopped the Yellow Jackets with 53-seconds remaining to seal the Chargers third win of the season. Quarterback Ryan Osiecki led the UNH offense with 219 yards and two touchdowns on 23-of-31 passing. Demetrius Washington-Ellison caught both touchdowns and five passes total for 55 yards. Defensively, Rob Hill led the Chargers with seven tackles, while Moses White and Desmond Anderson both tallied two pass break ups. The Chargers return to action on Saturday when they travel to Merrimack for a 1 p.m. kickoff.



**PACE:** Greg Brain led the Setters with seven total tackles along with a forced and recovered fumble in the Setters loss to Stonehill College. Brian also had a 30-yard interception return to the Stonehill two-yard-line to set up a Pace touchdown. The Setters are 0-6 for the first time since the 2004 season. Pace will take on Bentley University this Saturday, October 17 at 1 pm on Homecoming weekend for the Setters.



**SAINT ANSELM:** Saint Anselm is coming off a bye week this past weekend, its first bye week since the 2003 season. The Hawks host Assumption College on Saturday at Grappone Stadium in the 11th all-time meeting with the Greyhounds. The all-time series is tied at 5-5, with the last Saint Anselm win coming by a 26-17 final in 2004 in Worcester, Mass. The Hawks offense continues to be led by the explosive duo of sophomore Marc Wilson and freshman Michael Pierce. Pierce is currently ranked second in the Northeast-10 in passing yards per game (240.7) and third in total offense per game (259.7). One of his favorite targets, Wilson is tied for second in receptions per game (6.5), is fourth in receiving yards per game (82.3) and is fourth in all-purpose yards per game (143.3). On the defensive side of the ball, senior All-America candidate Dan Bohenek is fourth in the Northeast-10 at 11.0 tackles per game. The Hawks also boast the two top freshman tacklers in the conference as Chris Bent is seventh with 8.8 tackles per game, followed by Ethan Sylvain in ninth at 8.7 stops per game. Sylvain is a two-time Northeast-10 Freshman of the Week.



**SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT:** The Owls had a streak of 26 consecutive wins on or after Oct. 1 snapped on Friday night with a 17-14 loss at Bentley. The Owls hadn't lost a game in the regular season on or after Oct. 1 since 2004. Jarom Freeman (Peekskill, N.Y.) led the squad with 115 yards rushing on Friday night.



**STONEHILL:** Stonehill came off the bye to notch its first Northeast-10 victory of the season with a 34-14 win over Pace. The Skyhawks defense held Pace to just 14 points and only 62 yards rushing as they posted seven sacks and 15.0 total tackles for a loss of 80 yards, while adding three interceptions. Senior defensive end Andrew Lesko (Florence, Mass.) led the defense with ten tackles (eight solo), including 5.0 for a loss of 37 yards and 2.0 sacks for a loss of 18. Freshman Jared Gaines (Lumberton, N.J.) totaled a team and season-high 13 tackles (seven solo). Sophomore Stephan Neville (Foxborough, Mass.) intercepted his team-leading fourth pass of the year. Senior Greg Sanzari (Centerport, N.Y.) added a second quarter pickoff which he returned 23 yards for a touchdown to put the Skyhawks up 27-0. It marks the Skyhawks first interception return for a touchdown since Mark DeBye picked off a pass at Assumption and ran it back 35-yards for a score on September 4, 2005. Sophomore quarterback Danny Sagan (Blairstown, N.J.) returned after missing five and a half weeks due to injury and completed 10-of-21 passes for 125 yards and two touchdowns - the first two scoring passes of his career. He also carried the ball 11 times for 21 yards and a score.

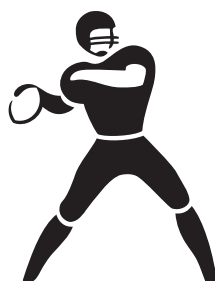
