Matt Zahoruiko, Bentley (Sr., LB, North Andover, Mass.) - In Bentley's 28-27 win over Pace, tied his career-high in tackles (15) for the second straight game, recovered a fumble at his own seven in the first quarter, made a red-zone interception in the second quarter and forced a fumble (recovered by the Setters) in the third. Tackles included nine solo and one for a loss. Reached the 100-tackle plateau for the second straight year.

2009 NORTHEAST-10 FOOTBALL WEEKLY INFORMATION



AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL: AIC was off last week and will return to action Saturday when it hosts Merrimack at 1 p.m. at Ronald J. Abdo Field.



ASSUMPTION: Junior running back Herbert Woodard (Bridgton, Mass.) rushed 17 times for 163 yards and four TDs leading Assumption past Saint Anselm College (45-12) Saturday. He ran 64 yards on the first play to tie the game and later scored from three, one and 38 yards to pace the Hounds to their third straight win. In the process, he became the varsity career rushing leader with 2,431 yards passing Fran DeFalco '94 (2,289 yards). He also passed the 'club' leader Rich Dandini '89 (2,335). He is also the first to have 10 100-yard rushing games and tied DeFalco for the most rushing touchdowns (29) in a career. His 192 career points are just 12 points short of DeFalco's career mark of 204. He has rushed for 420 yards and nine TDs in two career games at Saint Anselm (ran for 277 yards and five touchdowns as a freshman) and has rushed for 385 yards and scored seven touchdowns in the last two weeks. Senior middle linebacker Dustin Zitzmann (Pinellas Park, Fla.) led the team with 5-0--5 tackles and now has 144-236--380 for his career, third behind Scott Stephens '93 (70-117--387) and Bill Guilfoil '95 (275-134--409).



BENTLEY: Bentley needed a late interception from senior safety Chris Carroll (Lynn, Mass.) and a 15-play, 91-yard drive, capped by an eight-yard TD pass from Bryant Johnson (Hopedale, Mass.) to Kelley Rowe (Toledo, Ohio) with 18.6 seconds left, to pull out a 28-27 victory at Pace University Saturday. The victory kept the Falcons, number our in last week's NCAA Division II Super Region One rankings, tied for first in the Northeast-10. Senior linebacker Matt Zahoruiko (North Andover, Mass.) had a career-high 15 tackles for the third time this season, and also topped the century mark in tackles for the second consecutive season. Rowe surpassed the 1,000 yard mark in career receiving, and Carroll had his eighth interception, tying for the second highest single season total in school history.



MERRIMACK: The Warriors returned to its winning ways, racking up a season-high 48 points and 483 yards in a 48-20 win over New Haven in the first-ever meeting between the two teams. James Suozzo (Everett, Mass.) rushed for three more touchdowns while throwing for two, amassing 290 total yards in the win. Chris Laham (Westwood, Mass.) broke yet another school record as he is now the all-time school leader for career receiving yards with 2,298. After rushing for under 100 yards for the first time this season in last week's loss to Assumption, Anthony Smalls (Dorchester, Mass.) returned to form, getting 140 yards on 21 carries. The Warriors totaled 34 first-half points, improving to 4-1 at home this season. Merrimack hits the road for two critical games beginning at American International next Saturday at 1 p.m. in the Northeast-10 'PackCast' Game of the Week before a showdown with Southern Connecticut on October 30.



NEW HAVEN: New Haven fell 48-20 Saturday afternoon at Merrimack College. With the loss, the Chargers fall to 3-4 overall and 2-4 in the Northeast-10 Conference. Offensively, Ryan Osiecki led the way with 256 yards and three touchdowns on 22-of-34 passing. Sharieff Hall and Chris Ruffin led the receiving corps with eight and five catches, respectively. The Chargers return home this weekend to take on Pace University at DellaCamera Stadium.



SAINT ANSELM: Saint Anselm dropped a 45-12 final to Assumption on Homecoming this past Saturday, giving Assumption a 6-5 lead in the all-time series. Sophomore wide receiver Marc Wilson set another pair of single-game school records as he finished with 274 all-purpose yards and 209 kickoff return yards. Wilson returned the opening kickoff 92 yards for a touchdown, the second-longest kickoff return in Saint Anselm history and just the second returned for a touchdown. He also was 2-for-2 passing for 60 yards and had six catches for 64 yards. Wilson leads the league in all-purpose yards per game with 162. He is also second in receptions per game at 6.43 and receiving yards per game at 79.7. Freshman Michael Pierce is fourth in the league in passing yards and third in total offense with 237.3 and 255.3 yards, respectively. Three Hawks rank in the top 10 defensively in tackles per game, led by senior All-America candidate Dan Bohenek in fourth with 10.9 per game. Freshman Ethan Sylvain, who is second in the league in interceptions, is sixth in tackles at 8.9 and is the top freshman tackler in the league. Freshman Chris Bent is also 10th at 8.1 tackles per game. Sylvain, Bent, Dale DeGraw and Mike Hobbs are the top four freshman tacklers in the league. Saint Anselm travels to Stonehill this Saturday for a 1 p.m. kickoff at W.B. Mason Stadium.



SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT: The Owls jumped back in the win column with a convincing 42-14 win over Stonehill on Homecoming. Junior John Wiechman (Buxton, Maine) led the ground game with 137 yards on 11 carries. Rashaad Slowley (Mount Vernon, N.Y.) had 97 yards on 13 carries. Andre Privott (Middletown, Conn.) paced the receivers with six catches for 134 yards and two touchdowns. SCSU has an off week this weekend before hosting Merrimack on Oct. 30.



STONEHILL: Stonehill looks to bounce back from Saturday's set back at Southern Connecticut on Saturday when it hosts Saint Anselm College as part of Alumni Weekend at the College. Sophomore Stephan Neville (Foxborough, Mass.) led the defense with 11 tackles while also compiling 124 yards on three kickoff returns. Senior defensive lineman Andrew Lesko (Florence, Mass.) leads the NE-10 and was ranked second nationally last week with 7.5 sacks. He also leads the Conference with 14.5 tackles for a loss, ranking fourth nationally last week, and ranking as the ninth-highest single-season total in program history. Freshman defensive back Jared Gaines (Lumberton, N.J.) recovered a fumble and returned it 30-yards for his first collegiate touchdown on Southern Connecticut's first offensive play from scrimmage. It's the Skyhawks second fumble return for a score and marks the second-straight year Stonehill has returned a fumble for a touchdown against the Owls.
