NORTHEAST-10 OFFENSIVE PLAYER AND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK



Michael Pierce, Saint Anselm (Fr., QB, Andover, Mass.) - Pierce finished with a school-record 496 yards of total offense in Saturday in a 31-28 loss at Stonehill. His 496 yards are the Northeast-10 season high by nearly 60 yards. Pierce was 36-for-74 for 390 yards and three touchdowns, as well as running for 106 yards. Pierce threw touchdown passes of 47, 16 and 7 yards as the Hawks rallied from a 21-7 deficit to take a 28-24 lead in the final minutes. Pierce set Saint Anselm single-game records for passing yards (390), total offense (496), total plays of offense (89) and pass attempts (74).

Terrence Holley, American International (Jr., LB, Bronx, N.Y.) - Holley had a team-best 13 tackles (six solo) with 1.5 tackles for loss, one forced fumble and an interception that he returned 42 yards for a touchdown in the 41-13 win over Merrimack.



Matt Zahoruiko, Bentley (Sr., LB, North Andover, Mass.) - In Bentley's come-from-behind win over Assumption, made eight of his ten tackles in the second half, recovered a fumble at the Greyhound six to set up Falcons' winning touchdown and made an interception with 2:16 left to end Assumption's final possession.

2009 NORTHEAST-10 FOOTBALL WEEKLY INFORMATION



AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL: AIC's defense forced seven turnovers and held Merrimack to a season-low 13 points in a dominating 41-13 win in Springfield. Senior running back Amadeus Guerrero-Pou had 25 carries for 158 yards and scored two TDs, while senior quarterback Shane Murphy went 12-of-28 for 154 yards and two scores. Both of his TD passes were on fourth-and-two. Senior wide receiver Kertis Hussey had three catches for 46 yards and one TD and became the fifth 2,000-yard receiver in program history. Senior Terrence Holley finished the game with a team-best 13 tackles (six solo) with 1.5 tackles for loss, one forced fumble and an interception, while Thompson ended the day with 12 tackles (five solo), two tackles for loss, one sack and one forced fumble. AIC picked off James Suozzo five times in the game, with senior Nathaniel Ricks and sophomore Max Brown picking him off two times each. Holley and Ricks both had interceptions they returned for touchdowns.



ASSUMPTION: Junior running back Herbert Woodard (Bridgton, Mass.) rushed 27 times for 104 yards and two TDs against Bentley Saturday. In the process, he became the first Greyhound to pass the 2,500 yard mark for a career and now has 2,535 yards. He is also the first to have 11 100-yard rushing games and past DeFalco for the most rushing touchdowns (31) in a career and the most touchdowns (33) overall. His 204 career points tied DeFalco for the career mark. Senior middle linebacker Dustin Zitzmann (Pinellas Park, Fla.) led the team with 7-4--11 tackles. He now has 151-240--391 for his career, second behind Bill Guilfoil '95 (275-134--409). Senior wide receiver David Canney (Templeton, Mass.) had six receptions for 82 yards and now has 139 in his career for 1,815 yards.



BENTLEY: After having its four games during the month of October decided by a total of 10 points, Bentley will enjoy a bye this coming Saturday before wrapping up the regular season Nov. 7 at Stonehill. The 24-20 Homecoming win over Assumption was the fifth Bentley game this season in which the final spread was four points or less. The Falcons have come up with 16 takeaways in the last three games and have had at least three in seven of the last eight games. Bentley's eight wins is its highest total since the 2004 season finished at 8-2. When senior LB Matt Zahoruiko (North Andover, Mass.) captured last week's Gridiron Club of Greater Boston Gold Helmet, he became the third different Falcon to win the prestigious award this season, following Chris Carroll (Lynn, Mass.) and Bryant Johnson (Hopedale, Mass.).



MERRIMACK: The Warriors committed seven turnovers as they lost their second straight road game, falling to AIC 41-13 on Saturday. Two of Merrimack's three losses have been at the hands of the Yellow Jackets this season. With Anthony Smalls (Dorchester, Mass.) out of the lineup, James Suozzo (Everett, Mass.) was forced to throw 45 times and completed just 18 passes for 205 yards, while throwing five interceptions. Suozzo ran for 83 yards on 14 carries. Anthony Rebello (Achushnet, Mass.) picked up an interception, his second of the season, and 11 tackles. Shawn Loiseau (Shrewsbury, Mass.) led the defense in tackles for the fourth straight week with 16, giving him 101 on the season. Loiseau is the second Merrimack player in school history to reach the century mark and the first since 1999. He needs five more tackles to set the school record. The Warriors head to first-place Southern Connecticut next Friday night for their final road game.



NEW HAVEN: The Chargers defeated Pace University 49-27 at DellaCamera Stadium on Saturday. UNH held a 21-19 lead at the half and pulled ahead by nine in the 3rd quarter. New Haven sealed the win with a big 21-point 4th quarter, while holding the Setters to just eight second-half points. Quarterback Ryan Osiecki led the Chargers with 222 yards and three touchdowns on 21-of-34 passing. In the fourth quarter, Osiecki completed his 210th pass of the season, surpassing the Chargers' previous single-season record holder Jay McLucas (1990). Josh Smart also enjoyed an excellent day with a touchdown and 50 yards rushing, four catches for 41 yards and 70 total return yards. De-

fensively, Tom Herd led the Chargers with a sack, 2.5 tackles-for-loss and a 34-yard fumble return for a touchdown. The Chargers return to action in their final NE-10 contest of the season on Saturday, October 31 when they travel to St. Anselm College.



PACE: Freshman quarterback Joe Romanick tossed for 239 in the air with a pair of touchdowns in a loss to New Haven. Eric Ortega would throw for one touchdown and also scored a receiving touchdown in the game. Marvin Taylor led the Pace defense with eight total tackles, including a sack, while Jonfrey Sanchez also posted eight tackles.



SAINT ANSELM: Saint Anselm rallied from a 24-14 fourth-quarter deficit to briefly take a 28-24 lead before the Skyhawks rallied for a 31-28 win in the fourth annual Battle for the Ol' Bronze Hawk. In the game, Saint Anselm quarterback Michael Pierce finished with 496 yards of total offense on Saturday in a 31-28 loss at Stonehill. His 496 yards of total offense, along with his 390 passing yards and 74 pass attempts, are all Northeast-10 season highs. Pierce was 36-for-74 for 390 yards and three touchdowns, as well as running for 106 yards. Pierce threw touchdown passes of 47, 16 and 7 yards as the Hawks rallied from a 21-7 deficit to take a 28-24 lead in the final minutes. Pierce set Saint Anselm single-game records for passing yards (390), total offense (496), total plays of offense (89) and pass attempts (74). In addition, Pierce is now the Saint Anselm single-season record holder for passing yards, plays of total offense and yards of total offense with two games still to be played. Marc Wilson and Marcel Bouie became just the third Saint Anselm duo to each have 100 yards receiving in a game with 163 and 125 yards each, respectively. Wilson tied a single-game school record and Northeast-10 season high with 16 receptions as he piled up 163 yards and one touchdown. Bouie also finished in double digits with 10 catches for 125 yards and one touchdown. In addition to his receiving numbers, Wilson also set the Saint Anselm single-game mark for all-purpose yards with 299 yards, breaking his own record of 274 yards set just one week ago. Defensively, senior All-America candidate Dan Bohenek tallied a career-high 15 tackles, including two for a loss and one pass breakup. Bohenek now has 260 career tackles, moving him into second place on the Saint Anselm all-time tackles list. Freshman Ethan Sylvain, the leading freshman tackler in the Northeast-10, ended up with 11 stops, including six solo stops and a pair of pass breakups. In addition to their single-game records, Wilson and Pierce each set Saint Anselm single-season records today with two games still to be played. Pierce now holds the mark for total offense in a season with 2,283 yards, the first player to go over 2,000 yards, along with the passing yards mark at 2,051 yards and 493 plays of total offense. Wilson broke his own mark in all-purpose yards as he now has 1,433 yards and now holds the single-season mark for receiving yards with 721 yards. Wilson also now has 61 total receptions this season, tying him for the single-season mark. Saint Anselm returns to action at home on Saturday, October 31st as the Hawks host New Haven for a Noon start in the first-ever meeting between the two schools.



STONEHILL: Stonehill retained the Ol' Bronze Hawk trophy for the fourth-straight year after Saturday's 31-28 win over Saint Anselm... The Skyhawks visit Assumption College Friday at 7 p.m. Sophomore cornerback/returner Stephan Neville (Foxborough, Mass.) racked up 188 yards on four kick returns (47.0/return), including an 85-yard return for a touchdown on the game's opening kickoff. It was Neville's second TD return of the season (third career) and he also posted six solo tackles and three pass breakups on defense. Junior Eddie Vachon (Newton, Mass.) notched his second 100-yard game of the year with 113 yards on 23 carries and a touchdown, while adding a TD reception. He moved into fourth place on Stonehill's career rushing list with 1,602 career yards moving past Rob Olivar, who ran for 1,569 yards from 2000-03. Vachon sits just three yards behind Tyrone Jefferson (1998-2000) on the Skyhawks career all-purpose list with 2,922.
