NORTHEAST-10 CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK



Tim Martins, Le Moyne (Sr., Cortland, N.Y.) - Placed second at the Dowling September Shootout with a score of 146. Carded a 74 in the opening round and closed out the tournament with a 72.



D.J. Lantz, Southern New Hampshire (Jr., New London, N.H.) - Finished tied for eighth at the Dartmouth Invitational with a two-day score of 146. Shot a 71 in the first round Saturday, his lowest single-round score as a collegian.

Brian Foley, Saint Anselm (Fr., Worcester, Mass.) - Foley placed 27th at the Dartmouth College Invitational as the Hawks placed ninth as a team. Foley shot an opening-round 78 before coming in with a 73 in the final round for a 151 total.

ADELPHI: The Panthers placed sixth overall at the Dowling September Shootout. Adelphi's combined score of 620 was good enough for sixth overall, just a shot back of Nyack in fifth and nine back of fourth place LeMoyne. The Panthers also placed all five golfers in the top-50, including two in the top-10.



AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL: Junior Garrett Beyor placed fifth with an eight-over par 150 (77-73) to lead the American International College men's golf team to a third-place finish at the Dowling September Shootout with a two-day total of 610 (308-302). The 15-team tournament was held at the par-71 Long Island National Golf Club. Junior Greg Strattner tied for sixth with a 10-over 152 (77-75) and sophomore Kevin Daniels tied for 23rd with a 13-over 155 (78-77). Junior Kent Graham tied for 28th with a 14 over 156 (79-77), while freshman Colin Dansereau tied for 34th with a 15-over 157 (76-81).



LE MOYNE: Placed fourth at the Dowling September Shootout at Long Island National Golf Course with a score of 611. Senior Tim Martins (Cortland, N.Y.) finished the tournament in second place with a score of 146 on rounds of 74 and 72. The Dolphins return to action on Sunday and Monday at the Northeast-10 Championship in Bernardston, Massachusetts.



SAINT ANSELM: The Saint Anselm golf team placed ninth at the Dartmouth College Invitational last weekend, outdistancing Southern N.H. by nine shots as the only two Division II schools in the competition. Leading the way for the Hawks was freshman Brian Foley, who finished in a tie for 27th place. Foley shot a 78 in round one before firing a second-round 73 for a two-round total of 151. Classmate Tyler Fay finished two shots behind Foley with a two-round total of 153, shooting a second-round 79. Senior Jim Henebry was in a tie for 45th, improving seven strokes from his first round for a second-round 75 and a two-round total of 157. Freshman Emilio Bardini was tied for 57th place in 163, followed by Dylan McSparren tied for 63rd with a total of 167.



SAINT MICHAEL'S: The golf team placed first out of 5 teams at the Vermont State Championship on Wednesday, with a total of 321 on the 72-par course. Junior Mark Mitchell earned medalist honors with a two-under par 70. Junior Eric Haversang and sophomore Chris LaPolice found themselves in a three-way tie for fourth place, posting 83's. Over the weekend, the team competed in the Duke Nelson Invitational. The Purple Knights placed 19th out of 21 teams, one of their best finishes from previous seasons. Mitchell tied for 43rd place out of 105 golfers with a 19-over par, while sophomore John Goodwin tied for 61st place, finishing 23-over par.



SOUTHERN NEW HAMPSHIRE: Junior D.J. Lantz (New London, N.H.) posted a collegiate-best 71 in the first round of the Dartmouth Invitational Saturday. He finished tied for eighth in the meet, which featured a majority of Division I teams.

Le Moyne Favored To Repeat As Northeast-10 Men's Golf Champion

South Easton, Mass. – The Le Moyne College men's golf team was selected to claim this year's Northeast-10 Men's Golf Championship in a vote by the conference's 12 head coaches prior to the start of the season.

The two-day championship, which begins on Sunday, Oct. 4, will be held at the Crumpin-Fox Golf Club in Bernardston, Mass. The championship will conclude on Monday, Oct. 5 with a shotgun start beginning at 10 a.m. followed by the awards ceremony.

The Dolphins received five first place votes and a total of 134 points to edge out the University of Massachusetts Lowell who received two-first place votes and 112 points. American International College finished third with 104 points followed by Southern New Hampshire University who picked up one-first place vote and 98 points. The Penmen finished slightly ahead of Adelphi University by one vote. However, the Panthers picked up four-first place votes and round out the top five with 97 points.

Le Moyne took home the championship trophy last year for the first time in program history as the Dolphins shot an impressive 293 on day one. They followed that up on day two with a score of 306 to finish with a total score of 599 and a winning margin of 12 as UMass Lowell followed with a two-day score of 611. Saint Anselm College finished third with a score of 612.

Last year's medalist honors went to Le Moyne's **Kevin Jackson (Chittenango, N.Y.)** who finished the two-day championship with a score of 144 (69-75), just edging out American International's **Garrett Beyor (Monson, Mass.)** who finished with a total score of 145 (70-75). UMass Lowell's **Brendan Livingston (Westford, Mass.)** and the College of Saint Rose's **Matt Horton (Troy, N.Y.)** finished third and fourth respectively with scores of 146 and 147.
