2009 NORTHEAST-10 MEN'S SOCCER WEEKLY INFORMATION



AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL: The Yellow Jackets dropped a 1-0 non-conference decision to New York Institute of Technology and a 2-0 decision at Merrimack last week. Senior keeper Ryan Brooks-Newton had seven saves in goal for the two games.



ASSUMPTION: Junior forward Steve Blaisdell (Peabody, MA/Bishop Fenwick) is the Hounds' leading scorer with 8-3--19 points (second in the conference). Junior goalkeeper Brandan Sullivan (Halesite, NY/St. Dominics) has a 0.97 goals-against average with a .783 save percentage (36 saves) and four shutouts.



BENTLEY: Bentley earned three points out of two road games last week, tying with Saint Michael's 2-2 and beating Saint Rose 1-0. Two players, sophomore Eric Heuze (Geneve, Switzerland) and freshman Weston Zeiner (North Granby, Conn.) combined to produce all three of Bentley's goals. Zeiner scored twice, including the game-winner in the 89th minute against Saint Rose, and assisted on Heuze's goal against Saint Michael's. Heuze assisted on both of Zeiner's goals. The Falcons begin a three-game home stand Tuesday afternoon against UMass-Lowell, before closing out the week by hosting Southern Connecticut on Saturday.



FRANKLIN PIERCE: Franklin Pierce went 1-0-1 during the week, including a 2-0 win at Southern Connecticut State on Saturday, and a 2-2 draw at Saint Anselm on Wednesday. Graduate midfielder Frantz Francois scored both goals for Franklin Pierce in its win at SCSU. He now leads the team with six goals and is tied with Diego Tabares for the team lead in points with 12. The Ravens are on a three-game unbeaten streak and are 2-0-1 during that time. Sophomore Victor Goncalves scored twice in the Wednesday's tie at Saint Anselm. Sophomore goalkeeper Vinny Papageorgiou earned the win in net for Franklin Pierce on Saturday.



LE MOYNE: Went 1-0-1 in a pair of Northeast-10 Conference games. Defeated Assumption, 1-0, on Wednesday and played to a 0-0 draw at Saint Michael's on Saturday. Sophomore Marcus Debottis (Cicero, N.Y.) scored the only goal against the Greyhounds in the 53rd minute. Senior goalkeeper Steve White (Cortland, N.Y.) played all 200 minutes between the pipes and has recorded three consecutive shutouts, while extending his scoreless streak to 350:23.



MERRIMACK: The Merrimack men's soccer Warriors began the week with a 3-1 loss at #6 Southern New Hampshire where Swedish teammates Olof Lindhe (Stockholm) and Nelson Santos De Graca (Gothenburg) connected for the team's lone goal. Lindhe's goal was his second of the season, while Santos De Graca notched his first career point. The two freshmen are also two of four Merrimack players to participate in every game this season. Closing out the week, Merrimack knocked off American International at home thanks to Robbie Sabadoz's ninth and tenth goals in a 2-0 win.



NEW HAVEN: The Chargers suffered two losses this week, 3-0 at C.W. Post on Wednesday and 3-2 at Stonehill College on Saturday. Nick Dionne and Anthony Romano each scored goals for the Chargers, while Nick Pezzente and Roberto Novoa handed out assists. The pair of losses dropped UNH to 1-9 on the season and 0-8 in the NE-10. This week the Chargers travel to Le Moyne College on Tuesday and host Merrimack College on Friday.



SAINT ANSELM: The Saint Anselm men's soccer team extended their unbeaten streak to four games, going 1-0-1 in two home games this week. The Hawks tied Franklin Pierce, 2-2 in a dramatic double-overtime game in which three goals were scored in the last 15 minutes of the game, two coming with under three minutes left to play. The Hawks then defeated UMass-Lowell, 2-1 on Saturday in the pouring rain. Keesen Howe tied Wednesday's game with under two minutes to go and scored the game-winning goal on Saturday. Senior keeper John Corridan had a career-high 11 saves in Wednesday's tie, and last week's Freshman of the Week Eric Moriarty had seven saves, en route to his second consecutive victory on Saturday. The Hawks return to action on Tuesday, October 6th as they travel to Merrimack College for an NE-10 game beginning at 7:00 pm.



SAINT MICHAEL'S: The Purple Knights have averaged more playing time per game than any of their Northeast-10 rivals at this point in the season. On Saturday, they endured their fifth consecutive overtime appearance and their second double overtime tie of the week. The Purple Knights are currently tied for fourth place in shutouts in the conference (3) and in fourth place in saves, with Jason Burnett averaging 4.86 per game and recording a total of 38 in the conference.



SAINT ROSE: The Golden Knights went 0-2 last week, including a 1-0 setback versus Bentley Saturday afternoon. It marked the third time Saint Rose suffered a one goal decision in its last five outings. The Golden Knights have also outshot seven of their first 11 opponents and have generated a 61-46 edge in corner kicks.



SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT: Southern finished the week with a record of 1-1-1. On Wednesday, the Owls defeated Saint Rose, 4-1 in Albany, N.Y. Captain Paul Templeton led the way with two goals in the match. Cedric Panzu and Seth Ragaini also found the back of the net in the victory. With the win, the Owls have a very respectable record of 3-1 away from home. On Saturday, the Owls came up empty against Franklin Pierce, falling short 2-0 at Jess Dow Field.



SOUTHERN NEW HAMPSHIRE: SNHU, ranked No. 6 in last week's NSCAA national poll, has won five in a row and is unbeaten in its last 10 games (9-0-1). With a 10-1-1 record, the Penmen have posted their best record after 12 games since 1998, when SNHU was also 10-1-1. Southern New Hampshire saw a string of seven straight shutouts snapped in Wednesday's 3-1 win over Merrimack as the Penmen allowed their first goal in 787:35. Goalkeeper Sean Lambert (Rehoboth, Mass.) saw his personal shutout streak snapped at 719:46. SNHU, which has been ranked in the last 15 NSCAA Division II national polls dating back to last season, is currently tied for the fourth-longest streak of appearing in the poll.



STONEHILL: Stonehill bounced back from a tough stretch with a pair of wins in two matches last week. The Skyhawks topped UMass Lowell - an NCAA Tournament Quarterfinalist last term - 2-1 on Tuesday, before stopping New Haven, 3-2, on Saturday. Sophomore Michael White (Lisbon, N.H.) scored both Skyhawk goals in Tuesday's win over the River Hawks, while senior co-captain Shaun Keeley (Woburn, Mass.) netted a pair, including his team-best fourth match-winner, in Saturday's win over the Chargers. Stonehill has proven tough to beat at home this season, posting a 7-1-1 mark after its two wins last week. The Skyhawks are off this week until Saturday when they visit Saint Anselm College.
