AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL: AIC went 1-1-0 last week, beating Saint Rose 1-0 and falling at Saint Michael's 1-0. Sophomore Thomas Denomme scored AIC's goal against the Golden Knights, while senior Ryan Brooks-Newton made four saves to post the shutout in goal.



Brandon Sullivan (Halesite, NY/St. Dominic's) lowered his goals-against average to a stingy 0.88 and bettered his save pct. to .822 with his conference-leading seventh shutout.

ASSUMPTION: The Greyhounds played their second double overtime 0-0 tie in 11 days Saturday against Bentley (also on October 6 vs. Saint Rose). The team has allowed just two goals against Northeast-10 Conference competition this season at home (both by S.N.H.U.). Junior forward Steve Blaisdell (Peabody, MA/Bishop Fenwick) is third in the conference with 10-3--23 points. Junior goalkeeper



Bentley could not find the equalizer though the rest of the way. The Falcons then closed out the week with a scoreless draw at Assumption. Bentley has two tough road tests this week, at Southern New Hampshire on Tuesday night and at Merrimack on Saturday afternoon.

BENTLEY: The Falcons took one point out of two games last week, but still control their own destiny to clinch a Northeast-10 playoff spot. The week started with a 3-2 loss to Franklin Pierce. Trailing 1-0 early in the first half, a goal by junior Ryan Hatch (Haverhill, N.H.) leveled the match in the 19th minute, but the Ravens went into halftime up 2-1 with a goal in the 42nd minute. Franklin Pierce went up 3-1 in the



came early in the second half and proved to be the difference-maker in the win. Francois has scored four goals during his last three games. Senior Kevin Neumen scored a goal against Bentley, while Diego Tabares and Amory Houghton scored against Stonehill. Houghton's was the first of his collegiate career, as he is a freshman. Sophomore goalkeeper Vinny Papageorgiou made four saves against the Skyhawks to earn his second career shutout win against the school in as many tries. The Ravens are off during the middle of the week, but return to action on Saturday afternoon when they close out the regular season by playing host to Assumption at 2 p.m. at Sodexo Field.

FRANKLIN PIERCE: Franklin Pierce went 2-0-0 during the week; including a 3-2 win at Bentley on Wednesday night and a 3-0 win at home over Stonehill on Saturday night. Graduate midfielder Frantz Francois scored three goals during the week, including two game-winners. He scored twice in the win at Bentley, and his goal against Stonehill



night. Reina scored a goal in the 30th minute and recorded the assist on Jesse Carr's (Skaneateles, N.Y.) goal in the 46th minute. Senior goalkeeper Steve White (Cortland, N.Y.) made eight saves on the week to become the fifth Le Moyne goalkeeper to eclipse 300 career saves. With five points on the week, Reina moved into eighth place in the program's history in points (68) and goals scored (29). The Dolphins play their final non-conference game of the season on Tuesday against Bloomfield and host Stonehill on Saturday.

LE MOYNE: Le Moyne went 1-1 in a pair of road conference games last week. The dolphins dropped a 2-1 double-overtime decision at Southern Connecticut on Wednesday night. Junior Angelo Reina (Frankfort, N.Y.) scored just 35 seconds into the game for the Dolphins. The team closed out the week with a 2-1 win at Merrimack on Saturday



UMass Lowell suffered a 1-0 loss at Southern Connecticut Saturday and a 2-1 overtime heart-break at home against Saint Michael's Wednesday, marking the sixth and seventh matches lost by one goal this season.



MERRIMACK: Despite a league-leading 15th goal from sophomore Robbie Sabadoz (Ottawa, ON), Merrimack went winless on the week with losses against Le Moyne and Assumption. The 2-0 loss to Assumption marked the first time Merrimack had been shut out since October 22, 2008 against the same Greyhounds.



NEW HAVEN: The Chargers dropped two games this week. They lost 3-1 to Dowling on Tuesday and 4-1 to St. Anselm in an NE-10 match on Saturday. Jean Carlos Rafael and Nick Dionne scored the two goals for the Chargers this week, while Joel Rodriguez and Oren Corridon handed out assists. This week New Haven hosts Nyack on Tuesday, travels to Molloy on Thursday and takes on St. Michael's in Colchester, Vt. on Saturday.



SAINT ANSELM: The Hawks went 1-0-1 in two NE-10 games this week. The team faced the No. 5 first-place SNHU Penmen on Wednesday night and tied 1-1 in double overtime. The Hawks then returned home on Saturday for their final home game of the season, in which they beat New Haven, 4-1. It was Senior Day for the Hawks, and the class of '10 combined for three goals and seven points in the win. Senior Tyler Sangster had two goals and an assist on Saturday, senior Paul Kilday scored a goal in both games and sophomore Keesen Howe had an assist in both games. The Hawks return to action next Saturday, when they take on the American International Yellow Jackets.



SAINT MICHAEL'S: The Purple Knights currently sit in ninth place in the NE-10 standings after their wins last week. They have an opportunity to move up to a playoff seed this week, as they face Merrimack College who sits in the eighth seed at the moment. The men's senior game will be held on Duffy Field on Saturday, as the Purple Knights will battle the New Haven Chargers at noon and honor their three seniors.



SAINT ROSE: The Golden Knights suffered a pair of Northeast-10 Conference setbacks this week. On Wednesday, Saint Rose endured its fifth one-goal setback of the season via a 1-0 loss versus American International College. On Saturday, defending NE-10 Champion and fifth-ranked Southern New Hampshire broke open a 0-0 deadlock by scoring three times within a five-minute span to come away with a 4-1 win over the Golden Knights. Sophomore keeper Patrik Ohlsson leads the league with a 5.07 save average having stopped 76 shots in 15 games.



SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT: The sophomore class led the men's soccer team to a perfect 2-0 week. Sophomore Jason Villagomez scored the game-tying goal with 1:37 left in regulation and sophomore Eric Vazquez added the game-winner in double overtime, as Southern upset No.18 Le Moyne, 2-1 at Jess Dow Field on Wednesday night. Seth Ragaini collected his seventh assist in the first goal and sophomore Paul Templeton assisted the game-winner. Sophomore Cedric Panzu lifted the Owls in the 83rd minute against UMass-Lowell on Saturday night. Matan Bik assisted Panzu as the Owls edged the Riverhawks, 1-0.



SOUTHERN NEW HAMPSHIRE: The Penmen extended their unbeaten streak to 13 games (10-0-3) with a 1-1 tie against Saint Anselm Wednesday and a 4-1 win over Saint Rose Saturday. The unbeaten streak is SNHU's longest since 2002 when it was unbeaten in 16 straight contests. The Penmen have also won seven of their last eight games. Five different players scored Southern New Hampshire's five goals last week. The Penmen, who were fifth in the adidas/NCAA Division II poll last week for the second straight week, can clinch their second straight Northeast-10 regular season title with a win in either of their final two league contests, at home against Bentley Tuesday night or at home against Southern Connecticut Saturday evening.
