AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL: AIC dropped decisions to Southern Connecticut, 4-0, and Saint Anselm, 2-1, last week. Senior Ohionameh Aregbeyen scored the Yellow Jackets lone goal against the Hawks.



ASSUMPTION: The team has qualified for its second straight Northeast-10 Conference playoff action against a still-to-be-determined first round opponent. The team allowed just two goals against Northeast-10 Conference competition this season at home (both by S.N.H.U.). Junior forward Steve Blaisdell (Peabody, MA/Bishop Fenwick) is the leading scorer with 10-3--23 points. Junior goalkeeper

Brandon Sullivan (Halesite, NY/St. Dominic's) lowered his goals-against average to a stingy 0.82 and bettered his save pct. to .848 and a team-record seven shutout this season (and a record 15 for his career).



BENTLEY: Bentley lost both of its games last week, 3-1 at No. 5 Southern New Hampshire last Tuesday and 4-0 at Merrimack last Saturday. Despite the results, Bentley maintains control of its own destiny for clinching a spot in the playoffs, needing a win at home against Saint Anselm on Tuesday. If the Falcons qualify for the postseason, it will be their second straight appearance, and the second straight year they've qualified on the last day of the regular season.



FRANKLIN PIERCE: Franklin Pierce went 1-0 during the week with a 1-0 win over Assumption on Saturday in the regular season finale. Sophomore midfielder Diego Tabares scored the lone goal in the win for the Ravens as it was his sixth of the season and his third game-winning goal. Sophomore goalkeeper Vinny Papageorgiou needed

to make just one save in the contest to run his record to 10-2-1 on the season, and record his seventh shutout of the campaign. Franklin Pierce concluded the regular season on an eight-game unbeaten streak (7-0-1).



LE MOYNE: Went 2-0 in a pair of home games last week. Senior back Davide DiPaola (Rochester, N.Y.) headed in the game-winner off a free kick in the 86th in a 3-1 win over Bloomfield on Tuesday. Sophomore Josh Mabee (Clifton Park, N.Y.) tallied the game's first goal and junior Angelo Reina (Frankfort, N.Y.) added an insurance goal in the 88th

minute. DiPaola registered another game-winning goal off a header on a free kick in the 79th minute in a 2-1 win over Stonehill on Saturday. Sophomore Greg Pardo (O'Fallen, Mo.) tied the score at 1-1 in the 50th minute to set up DiPaola's eventual goal. Sophomore Jesse Carr (Skaneateles, N.Y.) assisted on three of the five goals in the week, including both game-winners. The Dolphins finished the season undefeated at home for the second consecutive season and wrap up the regular season on Tuesday against Saint Rose.



UMASS LOWELL: UMass Lowell defeated Saint Rose, 2-0, Saturday in its regular season home finale, after honoring its seven seniors: goalkeeper Ryan Richards, defenders Rudy Kocandrle, Corey Samuelson, Mike Clem and Mike Galvin; midfielder Jhony Valencia and forward Jeff Danso.

The victory halted a nine-match slide for the River Hawks, of which six losses were by one goal. UMass Lowell caps the 2009 season Wednesday night at Merrimack.



MERRIMACK: In a 2-0 week for Merrimack, a pair of Warriors had their first two goals of the season in a 4-0 win over Bentley on Saturday. Freshman Nelson Santos De Graca (Gothenburg, Sweden) scored his first two career goals in the first half against the Falcons before sophomore Evan Burokas (Auburn, MA) buried two second half goals. Earlier

in the week, freshman Olof Lindhe (Stockholm, Sweden) scored his third of the year to lift the Warriors 1-0 over the Owls of Southern Connecticut. Capping a three-game win streak, the Warriors have made it five straight seasons with 10+ wins and a top-five finish in the Northeast-10 Conference standings.



NEW HAVEN: The Chargers dropped three matches this week. On Tuesday they fell, 1-0, in double overtime to Nyack College, while also dropping a one-goal decision, 2-1, to St. Anselm on Saturday afternoon. Oren Corridon and Jean Carlos Rafael each scored goals for New Haven this week. The Chargers will conclude their 2009 season on Wednesday, October 28 when they host American International at Kayo Field at 2:30 p.m.



SAINT ANSELM: The Hawks clinched a guaranteed spot in the Northeast-10 Tournament on Saturday with a 2-1 defeat of the American International Yellow Jackets. Keesen Howe (Norwich, Conn.) and Paul Kilday (Marshfield, Mass.) both scored in the game. The Hawks will conclude their regular season on Wednesday afternoon when they travel to Bentley University.



SAINT MICHAEL'S: On Saturday, the men's soccer team honored their three seniors in their final home contest of the season: Jared Berry, Jason Burnett and Joe Ruggieri. The Purple Knights will travel to Stonehill College on Wednesday in hopes of earning the points they need to have a chance at reaching the quarterfinals of the playoffs. The Purple Knights currently sit two seeds

ahead of the Skyhawks in the NE-10 standings. In order to secure the eighth seed for playoffs, Saint Anselm will have to tie or defeat the Bentley Falcons, at Bentley, on Wednesday.



SAINT ROSE: The Golden Knights went 0-2 last week following a 2-0 setback at UMass Lowell and a 1-0 loss versus Queens College. The latter marked the sixth one-goal setback of the season for Saint Rose. Sophomore keeper Patrik Ohlsson added to his league-leading save total by registering a combined 14 stops throughout the two contests.



SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT: Southern went 2-1 on the week, including wins against AIC and Southern New Hampshire and a 1-0 loss at Merrimack. In Springfield, Mass. on Tuesday, the Owls received goals from four different members of the squad. Yoni Feldman, Cedric Panzu, Paul Templeton and Eric Vazquez each scored goals, while Jeremy Tavares, Harry Appiah and Templeton

assisted goals in the victory. On Saturday, Victor Hernandez and the Owls locked up fourth place in the NE-10 standings as Southern Connecticut upset Southern New Hampshire in Manchester, N.H. Tavares granted the Owls an assist while Hernandez scored his fourth and fifth goals of the season in the game.



SOUTHERN NEW HAMPSHIRE: The Penmen wrapped up their second straight Northeast-10 regular season title with a 3-1 win over Bentley on Tuesday. It also marks SNHU's second NE-10 regular season title overall, and first outright title, as the Penmen shared last season's crown with UMass Lowell. The Penmen are 19-2-5 in

conference play over the last two seasons. Southern New Hampshire saw a 14-game unbeaten streak snapped with a 2-1 loss to Southern Connecticut on Saturday. It was SNHU's longest unbeaten streak since a 16-game streak in 2002. Following a non-league game at Bridgeport on Wednesday, the Penmen will open up NE-10 tournament play Sunday at home.
