Northeast-10 Men's Track Athlete of the Week

Hafiz Greigre, Bryant (Sr., Attleboro, MA) - Earned an NCAA provisional mark last week in the 200-meters, took three first-place honors at Smith with a first place in the 55-meters in 6.47 seconds and later placed first in the 200m in 21.93 seconds. Captured first in the men's long jump, clearing 21 feet, 2.75 inches.

Toni-Marie Henry, UMass Lowell (Sr., Springfield, MA) - Captured two events at the Tufts University Stampede. Won the 55-meter dash in 7.24 seconds as well as the 200-meter dash in 25.51 seconds.
